EASTER TRIDUUM

The Triduum is a 3-day period of prayer in preparation of the Easter feast. Triduum recall the 3 days Jesus Christ spent in the tomb. We observe the Triduum from Holy Thursday until Easter Sunday. It is one liturgy over a 3-day period.

HOLY THURSDAY, APRIL 14, 2022, (Bilingual) 7p.m.

After listening to the Scriptures, we have washing of the feet. Jesus gave us the image of what the church is supposed to look like, feel like, act like.

Next, we take up collection. The liturgy makes it clear that tonight's collection is only for the poor. So, bring your Rice Bowl money you have saved with Lenten fasting, or non-perishable food products. Like washing of the feet, this is a rehearsal for Christian life. Then we celebrate the Eucharist.

After Communion the Blessed Sacrament is carried in solemn procession to the gathering space, where there will be exposition until 10 p.m.; all are invited to stay and pray awhile. The evening liturgy has no ending; the altar is stripped; all leave the church in silence.

GOOD FRIDAY, APRIL 15

Stations of the Cross - 3p.m. (English)

Good Friday Service – 5p.m. (Spanish)

Good Friday Service – 7:30p.m. (English)

We gather quietly and listen to the scripture, including the passion from St. John's Gospel. We pray at length for the world's needs.

Then there is another once -a-year event; the cross is held up in our midst. We are invited to come forward to venerate it with a kiss, a touch, a bow, or genuflection. All the while we sing not only of sorrow, but also of the glory of the cross.

We continue in fasting and prayer and vigil in rest and quiet through Saturday. This Saturday for us is Christ's repose in the tomb.

HOLY SATURDAY, APRIL 16, 8:30p.m.

Hungry now and excited, we celebrate the Easter Vigil. We gather in the darkness and light a new fire and the Pascal Candle. We listen to some of the most powerful scripture reading, the story of creation, Moses and the crossing of the sea, the Gospel of the resurrection.

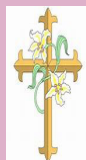
Then we pray to all the saints to be with us as we go to the font and bless the water. Then the Catechumens renounce evil, profess their faith of the church and are baptized. The other candidates to be received into full communion with the church join us in renewing our baptismal vows. We witness the Sacrament of Confirmation administered to all these new members.

Now the Neophytes, together with the Catholic Community, celebrates the Easter Eucharist. Easter begins and we are ready for fifty days of rejoicing.

Pastor's Report for March 2022

The improvement in sound for the back of church was accomplished with an upgrade to our sound system. Thanks to Roger Costello and our sound engineer contractor, David Knight. This improvement is an example of how our Vision 2021 savings monies were spent

Let us pay attention to the expenses and revenue published in the bulletin. Through February, we are keeping expenses in check by \$30,000.00 to budget, but we are falling behind on revenue by \$11,000.00 to budget. Please create an automatic deposit for a weekly, monthly, quarterly offering to the parish. This is called ACH, and the beauty is it gives us a constant, stable stream of income throughout this year. Otherwise, people tend to donate less over the summer. Our fiscal year ends June 30, 2022, so let us be generous.
