**St. Rita Parish Council Meeting Minutes – April 18, 2022**

**Present:** Fr. Tobin, R Costello, T Cozzens, P Higgs, C Kubac, R Luna, T Schurfranz, A Weber, T Wheatley. **Absent:** C McKinnon, M Pike (excused).

Sandy Kmiec gave an update on the parish directory. The first draft was not acceptable. A message was to be drafted and placed in the bulletin to update the parishioners.

Financial report was provided. QR code for donating was live and in the bulletin; plans were made to post the QR code in the Narthex, also. To reach the homebound and evangelize, 9AM and 1 PM Masses will continue to be streamed.

A grant from the Lily Foundation has made it possible for members of the Hispanic community to participate in a multi-week Marian University course on evangelization. Offering this to other members of the parish will be discussed in September. Plans for the Synod on Synodality were discussed. Aaron Weber agreed to lead the synod on May 2 from 6:30-8:30. Archbishop Shelton Fabre will celebrate a regional Mass on Mon, May 16 at 7PM. Other parishes in the Preston Hwy corridor will be asked to participate. May's Parish Council meeting was moved to May 9 due to the Archbishop's Mass.

**Listening Session Successful**

A crowd of forty parishioners, twelve Anglos and twenty-eight Hispanics, met individually and then shared as a group on Monday, May 2 at St. Rita in the Casper Center, Cafeteria, and Church. Many thanks to our parish leaders, Aaron Weber and Flor Altamirano, who guided the English language and Spanish language individuals who met separately. Sharing the Church and seated together, the combined group prayed together and shared thoughts about the vitality of Saint Rita and who is missing. One suggestion that emerged was to share dancing. At the 100th anniversary social event of the parish, it was noticed by all that Anglo and Hispanic women spontaneously took to the floor at the sound of dance music. Could we include line dances drawing on say Mexican culture on the one hand and American Country Music on the other? Come to the picnic and other parish social events to see if we give this a try.

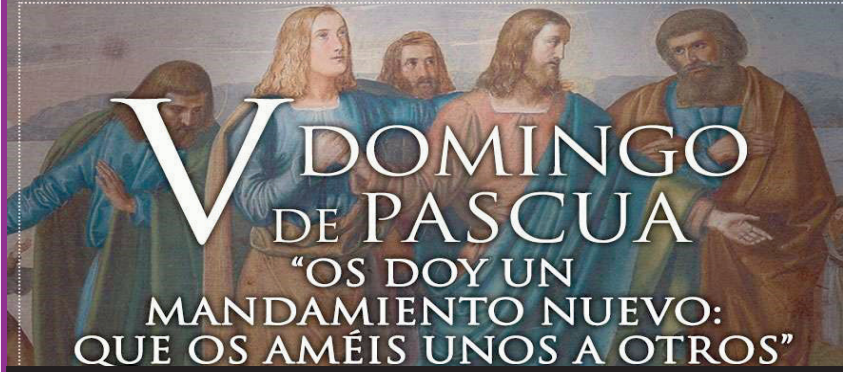
