Parishioners, let me ask your prayer and patience. It is necessary for all priests permanently serving in the Archdiocese to speak English. Fr. Jean has spent hours each morning at Ahrens School downtown in English as a Second Language and in the evenings with a family practicing reciting the Mass parts. Now it is time to practice in public. On May 8, Fr. Jean will celebrate the Mass and preach at 9a.m. and 11a.m. at St. Rita in English. As you enter church, please take a copy of his homily written in English. This practice of publishing the homily often satisfies parishioners concerned with being unable to fully understand their foreign-born priest. Remember that Fr. Jean is praying for you daily as you are his first American parish family. He asked me to share this with you. Please give Fr. Jean encouragement. For your information, he will then celebrate Masses at 4p.m. Saturday, May 14 at SL and 11a.m. Sunday, May 15 at SR with Deacon Ken Mitchell preaching these Masses. On May 21, Fr. Jean will celebrate the Mass and preach at 5p.m. and again at 11a.m. on Sunday. On May 29, Fr. Jean will celebrate the Mass and preach at 9a.m. and 11a.m. Fr. Jean will regularly celebrate the Tuesday morning Mass at 8a.m. at Saint Luke.
