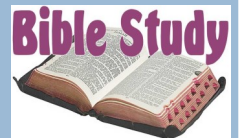

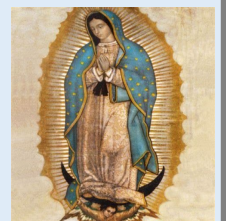

Children between the ages of 4 and 12 gather to pray the rosary as an invocation To the virgin of Fatima every Friday at 7 in the trailer.

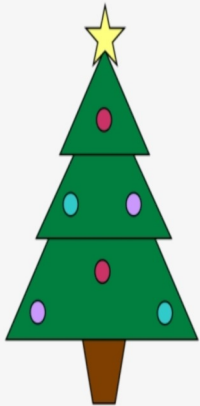
Youth Group
