THE Fr. JACK JONES FOOD PANTRY AT HOLY NAME PARISH

In 2024 the Fr. Jack Jones Food Pantry has distributed food to over 2,000 household members each month. In March, we averaged about 175 households and 506 members each week. Every week FJFP is open on Wednesday and Thursday from 10am to Noon, providing people with fresh produce, meat, and dry goods. The pantry is set up like a farmer's market outside of Holy Name Church and remains open come rain or shine. For anyone who wants to support the Fr. PARISH OFFICE STAFF SEEKS VOLUNTEER TO UPDATE SOCIAL COMMUNICATION:

The Parish Council at its April meeting heard a plea for improved use of the parish website. Like other businesses, schools, and even churches, we too need current news placed conveniently for parishioners to view on the web. The challenge will be to find a volunteer – training will be given – with dedication to weekly updating the parish website (for example the calendar feature) and other communication links like Facebook etc. Granted we already place the bulletin online via the website. Thanks to sponsors who subsidize the publication of the bulletin – please call on our sponsors - we are able to produce a weekly record of events. Young adults in greater numbers, however, scan websites for news of the parish. While bulletins typically must be limited in pages, websites can include entire pages dedicated to policies, procedures, registration forms, etc. Please speak to Roger Costello. Another device for communication is the Monitor on display in the Narthex of the church. Ideally, a calendar of events and other information would run during Masses for parishioners to scan as they come and go. It can also serve to transmit the Mass into the gathering space. We need volunteers to input the calendar during the week to be seen on the Monitor on Saturday and Sunday. We wish to switch from the calendar to watching the Mass and back to calendar before and after each Mass. If you can assist us with these tasks, either to set up the technology to perform these functions or to regularly update the calendar of events on the monitor, please see Roger.

CRUSADE FOR CHILDREN

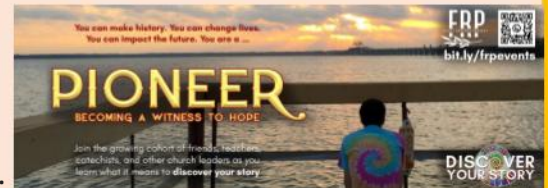

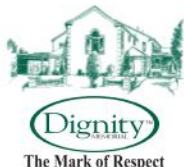
